Colorado Independent Ethics Commission Complaint

Steve Wadley, Archuleta County Commissioner

On or about September 22, 2015, The Archuleta County Commissioners, Todd Starr, County attorney and Bentley Henderson, County Administrator, engaged in a conspiracy to commit violations of CRS 18-8-404(1)(a)+(c), first degree abuse of office and official misconduct, to obtain benefit for another, and knowingly did engage in contracting with Todd Starr, to provide legal services in violation of CRS 24-18-201, interests in contracts, and violating CRS 18-8-407, embezzlement of public property.

Public notice of a Special Meeting on September 22, at 8:00 am, for the Board of Adjustment, had been posted.

As of October 2, 2015, a firm by the name of Rose Walker was listed with the Secretary of State, but no Rose Walker Starr.

This contract constitutes commission of overt acts in violation of CRS 18-8-404(1)(a)+(c), abuse of public office, first degree official misconduct, by Steve Wadley, obtaining benefit for another and personal financial gain to Mr. Starr. Steve Wadley did commit second degree official misconduct, CRS 18-8-405(1)(b), for violation of any statute or lawfully adopted rule or regulation relating to his office. As County Commissioner, Steve Wadley did participate in a conspiracy to create this contract and violate CRS 24-18-201. Steve Wadley did commit a violation of CRS 18-8-407, embezzlement of public funds, by establishing this contract and aiding Mr. Starr to receive public funds.

The full depth of the conspiracy won't be known until further investigation of the matter occurs. As it stands, Steve Wadley has engaged in withholding the recordings of the September 22, 2015 Special meeting Executive Session.


