



Summary of Conceptual Renewal Ideas

This table includes conceptual ideas we are considering for incorporation into the draft permit. The draft permit may include more ideas based on stakeholder input or other information received during preparation.

Conceptual Idea	Example	Objective
General permit number change	From COR030000 to COR400000	Provide additional certification issuance numbers.
Adjust layout of permit	Place all effluent limitations, recordkeeping requirements, etc. in one location.	Clarify various requirements in the general permit.
Provide clarity of permit requirements	Part I.D.8. - "...Where BMPs have failed, resulting in noncompliance with Part I.D.2, they must be addressed as soon as possible, <i>immediately in most cases</i> , to minimize the discharge of pollutants..."	Provide clarity and/or guidance that promotes compliance with requirements in the general permit.
Remove obsolete/duplicative requirements	Part I.D.3.d. - "Discharges to the ground of water from construction dewatering activities may be authorized by this permit..."	Removing requirements no longer needed.
Incorporate effluent limitation guidelines (ELGs)	Some of the requirements include maintaining a natural buffer around waters of the state when feasible and preservation of topsoil when feasible.	To meet the requirements of the federal register effluent limitation guidelines.
Minimum training requirement	Requiring qualified stormwater management plan administrator to obtain some level of training related to stormwater management.	Ensure that each project has an individual that is knowledgeable on appropriate stormwater management practices.
Owner/operator requirement	The co-permittees option would require both the owner and operator of a project to be responsible for compliance with requirements of the general permit.	Ensure that the owner and operator of a project are verifying that requirements of the general permit are being met.
