No. 1—The Fremont Water Supply Company's Canal July 15, 1885.

No. 2—The Stonehenge Reservoir and Canal, October 12, 1889.

No. 3—State Canal No. 1, June 12, 1889.

(41st)—That the water rights the owners of said first named canal cannot at this time be determined because the same have not been proven; and the last named two canals are not yet completed, so as to appropriate water.

(42nd)—That the reservoirs within said water district be, and are, hereby numbered according to their respective and several constructions; and said dates are determined to be as follows, to-wit:

No. 1—The Amsbary Ditch No. 1 Reservoir May 1, 1878.

No. 2—The Ute Park Ditch and Reservoir Feb 20, 1888.

No. 3—The Stonehenge Reservoir and Canal Oct. 12, 1889.

No. 4—The Woodruff Reservoir
