District Management Changes:

As mentioned in the last customer note, Special District Management Services (SDMS) has assumed management responsibilities for the District and has assigned Leon Gomes as District Manager. Leon heads up their Southern Colorado Branch and is a resident of Peyton. As of June 1, 2013, Leon has assumed the responsibilities of the previous District Administrator, Ellen Robley, whose work with the District concluded after 12 years of service.

2013 Consumer Confidence:

Enclosed is the mandatory 2013 Consumer Confidence Report for the Paint Brush Hills Metropolitan District (PBHMD). Please read this important document and learn more about your drinking water. In summary, our water continues to meet or exceed all Federal/State standards, with no violations occurring during the 2012 calendar year.

Changes to the irrigation schedule:

The 1.0 Mgal water storage tank has been taken off-line while it's being repaired. To more easily manage demand, the District is asking residents to observe the following watering schedule:

- **Odd-numbered house addresses:** Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday
- **Even-numbered house addresses:** Wednesday, Friday, and Sunday

Water Management and Voluntary Conservation:

With the watering schedule change in mind, PBHMD's 'Demand Management' strategy is in place for outdoor water use in Falcon Hills. The Board encourages residents to practice voluntary water conservation to reduce inefficient water use. Please adjust your sprinklers to water either early morning (before 8 a.m.) or late evening (after 6 p.m.) to minimize unnecessary water loss. Don't inadvertently water driveways, streets, or rock beds. Remember to cut back or eliminate watering during rainy periods. Drip irrigation systems for trees/shrubs can be used any day of the week. Low-volume hand water (for trees/plants/shrubs) is also acceptable any day using a watering can or garden hose equipped with a trigger nozzle.

Monthly Board of Director's meeting:

The next regularly scheduled meeting of the PBHMD Board of Directors will be held on Thursday, June 20th at 7 p.m. in the District office located at 9830 Liberty Grove Drive. Residents are encouraged to come and participate in any meeting of the Board and become familiar with all that the District does.
