Board Vacancy: The Board of Directors of the Paint Brush Hills Metropolitan District and the District's staff wish to express sincere appreciation to David Dalton for his three years of service to the District as a member of the Board. David recently resigned, leaving one (1) vacant seat.

This seat, which will be up for election in May 2014, will be filled through a Board appointment of an eligible elector of the District. An eligible elector is registered to vote in Colorado and is:

1. A resident of the District, or area to be included in the District, for not less than 30 days; or
2. The owner (or spouse of the owner) of taxable real or personal property situated within the boundaries of the District, or
3. A person who is obligated to pay taxes under a contract to purchase taxable property within the District.

If you are interested in being appointed to this position, please submit a letter of interest by mail or personal delivery to the District Office, or by email to Leon Gomes, District Manager, at lgomes@SDMSI.com. The Board will consider Letters of Interest received by 5:00 PM on Wednesday, July 10, 2013.

The letter should outline your reasons for wanting to become a director, your skills and work history, and a list of personal and professional references. Also, plan to attend the July board meeting where you will have the opportunity to introduce yourself and make a brief statement to the Board.
