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Strategic Direction Statement

To prevent and control chronic disease statewide, the Branch will **implement the Chronic Disease State Plan**, in conjunction with external partners, to coordinate and integrate evidence and practice-based strategies at both the individual and population level.

PURPOSE

- Provides a common vision and shared agenda for coordinated chronic disease prevention in Colorado.
- Provides a roadmap for CDPHE & partners working together to reduce burden of chronic disease in Colorado
 - ❖ **Higher level view – NOT a work plan**
- Promotes efficient and effective use of resources.

Key Outcomes

- Reduce the prevalence of obesity
- Reduce the prevalence of tobacco use
- Increase participation in USPSTF-recommended screening & early detection/self-management practices
- Advance health equity---health equity in all strategies
- Successfully implement & **align the A35 grants program**
- Increase effective partnerships and collaboration
- Ultimately reduce prevalence of CVD, Stroke, Diabetes, Cancer



Strategic efforts

Organized by 5 “Domains”

Focused across the following chronic disease domains:

- Data and Surveillance;
- Environmental Change and Policy Development;
- Clinical and Community Linkages;
- Health Systems Transformation; and
- Health Education and Communication.

Policy and Environmental Approaches

GOAL: To establish a system that supports coordinated CD prevention policies, practices, programming and environmental change at the state and community levels, with a focus on health equity in all strategies.

Health Systems Transformation

GOAL: Build on existing efforts to establish a comprehensive health system of prevention, early detection, treatment, and management of CDs

Clinical-Community Linkages

GOAL: Ensure linkages between clinical/healthcare settings and effective, evidence-based community resources for people with chronic disease and those at risk

Health Education & Communication

GOAL: Promote awareness and knowledge of chronic disease prevention, early detection, treatment and management among diverse key audiences, with an emphasis on health disparities and their root causes, including social & economic obstacles to health and limited English proficiency

Data and Evaluation

GOAL: To develop enhanced coordinated CD surveillance and evaluation efforts that inform planning for CD prevention and control
