Figure 1. Disparities in STIs by Race/Ethnicity in Zip Codes 80010, 2012




Figure 2. Chlamydia, Gonorrhea, Early Syphilis and New HIV cases among Coloradans in Zip Code 80010 reported to CDPHE, by month




Figure 3. Chlamydia Rate by Census Tract in Zip Code 80010, 2011-2012




Figure 4. Gonorrhea Rate by Census Tract in Zip Code 80010, 2011-2012







Figure 5. Early Syphilis Rate by Census Tract in Zip Code 80010, 2011-2012





- ◆ One in 185 Coloradans is living with HIV/AIDS in 80010 as of June 30, 2013.
- ◆ One quarter of those currently living with HIV disease in 80010 is foreign born, where 40% of those were born in Africa.
- ◆ About half of those currently living with HIV disease in 80010 have some evidence of care (42.7%), of those 70.9% have a suppressed viral load.

Figure 8. Percent of Persons Currently Living with HIV/AIDS in 80010 by Gender




Figure 9. Percent of Persons Currently Living with HIV/AIDS in 80010, by Country of Birth




Figure 10. Percent of Persons Currently Living with HIV/AIDS in 80010 by Current Age





Figure 11. Percent of Persons Currently Living with HIV/AIDS in 80010, by In Care Analysis
