A confidential and free service offered by Denver Public Health (DPH) that helps people living with or recently diagnosed with HIV access medical care and other support services.

The program assists HIV positive clients negotiate steps to secure accessible and affordable medical care. The DPH Linkage-to-Care program works in cooperation with all Denver area HIV medical providers, so clients can be referred and connected with care based on their individual insurance, geographic and personal preferences.

Services offered:

- HIV Testing
- Free T Cell and Viral load tests
- Help applying to financial programs or insurances that pay for medical care and medicines
- Expert and compassionate HIV health information
- Referrals to Case Management and other support services

La Gente is a bilingual HIV/AIDS services program specializing in providing client-centered services that assist HIV/AIDS infected individuals and their affected family members. The program offers intensive medical case management, mental health counseling, linkage to care and reengagement in care (early intervention services), medical transportation assistance, food bank assistance, HIV/STI testing and screening services, client advocacy, a cohesive referral system to qualified providers, community outreach, and much more.
