

## Key Steps for Selecting Interventions

1. Identify a list of interventions for each target population.
  - a. Identify and determine what interventions should be considered for each population.
  - b. Review possible HIV prevention interventions for each target population.
2. Determine what are the components of an effective intervention.
  - a. Develop a list, and collect the data, of the various types of information that the CPG will need to consider when assessing interventions.
3. Finalize a list of possible effective interventions per target population.
4. Describe an effective mix of interventions per target population.
