MEMORANDUM FOR All Pueblo Chemical Depot (PCD) Employees and Representatives

SUBJECT: PCD Policy Statement #20, Environmental Policy

1. This policy applies to all PCD personnel as well as tenants and lessees of PCD. Every employee and every contractor on PCD premises is expected to follow this policy and report any environmental concerns or instance of non-compliance to the Environmental Management Office immediately.

2. The Depot's mission is the safe and secure storage, monitoring, and destruction of the chemical stockpile; and preparation for depot closure. To accomplish our mission safely, PCD will adhere to the following environmental management principles:


a. Stewardship: PCD will be sensitive to the effects of our activities on human health and the environment because we believe in stewardship of the resources to which we have been entrusted. PCD will maintain environmental conditions while pursuing cleanup of legacy contamination to improve value for future generations.

b. Compliance: Compliance with all applicable legal and other requirements concerning protection of the environment is a priority for PCD. Any instance of noncompliance will be promptly corrected and appropriately reported.

c. Pollution Prevention: PCD will adhere to the following preferences, in descending order, for managing pollutants and waste generated at the site: source reduction, recycling, treatment, and then disposal. PCD will monitor the use of raw materials and utility resources for potential improvements in efficiency or environmentally beneficial alternatives. PCD will recycle and use recycled materials when economically beneficial.

d. Continual Improvement: PCD will consistently improve performance in ensuring environmental responsibility. Measurable environmental goals, objectives, and targets will be reviewed and updated annually. PCD will implement a continuous program of critical self-analysis to prevent, detect, and remedy noncompliance, as well as to promote improvements in practices that benefit the environment.
