The Colorado Environmental Leadership Program (ELP) is a voluntary program recognizing Colorado entities that go beyond compliance with environmental regulations and reach towards the goal of Sustainability.

The ELP consists of three levels: Bronze, Silver and Gold. There is no fee for participation and members can receive state incentives.

ON THE COVER Winner of the 2014 24-Karat Gold Award

Black Hills Energy's Energy Efficiency Education Program teaches 6th grade students how to be more energy efficient and to understand renewable energy systems and their benefits. Lessons they learn are taken home and help families become more energy efficient. This program saves customers over 930,000 kilowatt hours of electricity and 440,000 therms of natural gas which is equivalent to not burning 3,200,000 pounds of coal or not using 34,000 gallons of gasoline.

Rebranding Colorado & the ELP

COLORADO Logo



In 2011, Governor John Hickenlooper released his bottom-up plan for strategically evolving Colorado's economy. It was called the Colorado Blueprint. In it were six core objectives. One of them was a call to "create and market a stronger Colorado brand." The brand would work to unify Colorado—making its government more efficient while promoting tourism and business relocation. The Colorado logo and slogan "It's our nature" are intended to represent the state's world-famous mountains as well as Colorado's continued ascension in any number of categories, from business and innovation to agriculture and health.

As a result, CDPHE designed a new brand. The new logo is made up of the Colorado triangle called the Peak and the inverted CDPHE triangle called the Shield. Governors office tasked brandColroado, a group of industry and agency staff to create Shields for each agency based on agencies' characteristics. Our Shield shows the acronym with a two hands holding an aspen leaf. Below it, are the prairies and mountains in a line drawings.



COLORADO ENVIRONMENTAL LEADERSHIP PROGRAM (ELP) Logo



The ELP received both a "program logo" to be used on letterhead and ELP logo to be used by all members for marketing purposes which consist of a main ELP logo and appropriated level: Bronze, Silver or Gold. ELP members were included in the design process. The new logo, the leaves in a circle, represents environmental/sustainable continuous improvement. The green and blue represent the air, water and earth we are working so hard to preserve. And the blue and green tie in "Colorado" as they are the same shades of both the Colorado and CDPHE logos.

Founder & President, Earth Vision Institute & Extreme Ice Survey For 35 years, photographer James Balog has broken new conceptual and artistic ground on one of the most important issues of our era: human modification of our planet's natural systems. An avid mountaineer with a graduate degree in geography and geomorphology, James is equally at home on a Himalayan peak or a white-water river, the African savannah or polar icecaps.

To reveal the impact of climate change, James founded the Extreme Ice Survey (EIS), the most wide-ranging, ground-based, photographic study of glaciers ever conducted. He and the EIS team are featured in the 2012 internationally acclaimed, award-winning documentary *Chasing Ice* and in the 2009 PBS/NOVA special *Extreme Ice*. *Chasing Ice* won an Emmy® Award in 2014 and was shortlisted for the 2013 Academy Awards.

James is the author of eight books. *ICE: Portraits of Vanishing Glaciers* was published by Rizzoli International in 2012. Among his other titles are *Tree: A New Vision of the American Forest* (2004) and *Survivors: A New Vision of Endangered Wildlife* (1990), hailed as a major conceptual breakthrough in environmental photography.
