



Pollution Prevention Advisory Board Assistance Committee

Committee Member Application

House Bill 07-1288, also known as the Recycling Resources Economic Opportunity (RREO) Act, established a fund to incentivize implementation projects that promote economic development through the productive management of recyclable materials that would otherwise be treated as discards. Projects that meet this goal are designed to implement source reduction, recycling, composting, anaerobic digestion, and beneficial use/re-use for a wide variety of materials. The RREO fund supports a recycling rebate program. Revenues originate from a tipping fee of \$0.04 per cubic yard of trash dumped at Colorado landfills.

This act also created a 13-member Assistance Committee in order to assist the Pollution Prevention Advisory Board in overseeing the RREO Fund. Responsibilities include: 1) Make recommendations to the board in connection with the awarding of grants from the RREO grant fund. This includes reviewing grant applications and revising the Request for Applications document; 2) Serving as grant monitor for grant projects. This includes reading and commenting on project reports, approving any project budget reallocations, and attending site visits as needed; and 3) Develop a formula to calculate recycling rebates and make recommendations to the board in connection with the approval of rebate payments. Committee members are appointed by the Executive Director of the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment. All newly appointed members will serve a four-year term and have the option of being reappointed for two additional four-year terms.

The department is currently seeking one new member to fill a vacancy on the committee. One seat is available for an individual who is employed by OR has the ability to represent a Colorado for-profit business or nonprofit organization that is in some way connected to Colorado's recycling, reuse, remanufacturing, and/or compost industries. Additionally, the applicant may not be registered to vote as a member of the Democratic Party as the committee has reached the maximum number of Democratic Party members allowed by statute (HB 07-1288 dictates that the Assistance Committee will consist of 13 members with no more than 6 members from each political party).

For-Profit/Nonprofit Vacancy: For the purposes of this committee, any Colorado for-profit business or nonprofit organization licensed by the Secretary of State is eligible.
