



Pollution Prevention Advisory Board Assistance Committee

Committee Member Application

House Bill 07-1288, also known as the Recycling Resources Economic Opportunity (RREO) Act, established a fund to incentivize implementation projects that promote economic development through the productive management of recyclable materials that would otherwise be treated as discards. Projects that meet this goal are designed to implement source reduction, recycling, composting, anaerobic digestion, and beneficial use/re-use for a wide variety of materials. Revenues originate from a tipping fee of \$0.14 per cubic yard of trash dumped at Colorado landfills. The RREO Program exists to award grants and rebates from the RREO Fund.

This act also created a 13-member Assistance Committee in order to assist the Pollution Prevention Advisory Board in overseeing the RREO Fund. Committee members are appointed by the Executive Director of the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment. There are four seats that are currently vacant, and the individuals selected to fill these vacancies will serve the remainder of the previous member's term. There are two nonprofit/for-profit seats available, one that is term limited in August 2017 and the other in August 2019. There is one urban municipality seat available that is term limited in August 2019. Lastly, there is one rural municipality seat available that is term limited in August 2017.

To clarify eligibility, a representative of an urban or rural municipality may be employed by the municipality directly or be appointed by that municipality to represent them on this committee. A "rural municipality" is defined as an incorporated city or town with less than fifty thousand people that is located ten miles or more from another municipality with a population of more than fifty thousand people. An "urban municipality" is defined as any incorporated city or town with a population greater than fifty thousand people *OR* that is within ten miles of another municipality with a population greater than fifty thousand people.

All newly appointed members may be reappointed for two consecutive terms, four years in length.
