

## Pollution Prevention Advisory Board Assistance Committee

State statute requires that this 13-member committee must have no more than six members from each political party and must include:

- One member representing the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment
- One member representing the Colorado Office of Economic Development and International Trade
- One member representing the Governor’s Energy office
- One member representing a municipality situated in an urban county
- One member representing a municipality situated in a rural county
- One member representing from a urban county
- One member representing a rural county
- The remaining six members shall be balanced equally to the extent practicable among representatives of nonprofit and for-profit entities engaged in recycling or composting activities

All terms begin August 1 and are 4 years in duration.
