Colorado Road and Community Safety Act (SB13-251) services to be offered at three offices beginning June 1

April 14, 2015 – Denver, CO. Services for individuals unable to demonstrate lawful presence in the U.S. seeking a driver license, instruction permit or identification card under the Colorado Road and Community Safety Act (CO-RCSA SB13-251) will be offered at three offices beginning June 1, 2015:

- Denver Central - 1865 W. Mississippi Ave., #C, Denver
- Grand Junction - 222 S. 6th St., #111, Grand Junction
- Colorado Springs - 2447 N. Union Blvd., Colorado Springs

Appointments are required for individuals who are unable to demonstrate lawful presence in the U.S.

Individuals with confirmed existing appointments scheduled between June 1, 2015 and January 15, 2016 who wish to reschedule for another time or office may do so between April 27 and May 22 by calling 303-205-2335. They will be required to provide name, date of birth, appointment time and confirmation number. **Only individuals with previously confirmed CO-RCSA SB13-251 appointments should call the SB251 call center at this time.**

Individuals with confirmed existing appointments who do not wish to reschedule do not need to take any action. Their appointment will take place as currently scheduled.

Individuals without previously scheduled appointments should monitor www.colorado.gov/dmv for more information on the availability of new appointments. **No new appointments are available at this time.**
