Dear Senator Schwartz,

The Department of Personnel & Administration requests a waiver from the requirement to encumber professional services within six months of an appropriation becoming law, as required by Section 24-30-1404 (7) (a), C.R.S.

The waiver request applies to an appropriation for a Water Well and Sprinkler System Replacement at Camp George West. The appropriation was erroneously placed in the Department of Public Safety's Controlled Maintenance section of the Long Bill. Since the appropriation is placed in the wrong section of the bill, the Department of Personnel & Administration cannot encumber funds for this purpose until a legislative change is made to move the appropriation to the Department of Personnel & Administration's section of the bill.

This issue has been addressed with Legislative Council Staff, who will suggest a technical adjustment to the appropriation through a supplemental bill in January 2015.

For these reasons, the Department of Personnel & Administration requests that the CDC recommend that this waiver be granted by the State Controller.
