

OUT OF STATE RESIDENT NEEDING LEVEL I OR LEVEL II TO REINSTATE

Fee:

The person must be eligible to reinstate their driving privilege in Colorado and pay the appropriate reinstatement fee.

Insurance:

The person must provide the appropriate insurance information.

Level I or II:

Provide an evaluation by an alcohol treatment center or alcohol therapist, with proof of completion of their recommendations. This should include: hours required, beginning and ending dates and prognosis to fulfill their requirements. This evaluation should be on letterhead for the alcohol treatment center or therapist.

If, in their opinion, no further treatment is required, then this is acceptable as long as we receive written confirmation from the alcohol treatment center/therapist on letterhead.

Colorado is a member of the driver license compact per Title 24 (C.R.S.). The Administrative Procedures Manual (1994) states the following for all compact states.

A state shall not be required to issue a clearance if an evaluation performed in the new state of residence as provided in 2.6.2.2 indicates that the person is not fit to drive safely. (2.6.2.4)
