Without your parent or legal guardian's notarized signature, the Department will return these documents to you and you will be required to appear in court with your parent or legal guardian on the date designated on the penalty assessment notice [C.R.S. 42-4-1707(3)(a.5)(III)(C)].</p> <p>If you have received a summons into court or decide to contest the charge(s) on a penalty assessment, you are required to appear in court with a parent or legal guardian on the date designated on the citation or as designated by the court [C.R.S. 42-4-1710].</p> <p>A parent or legal guardian of a dependent minor is required by law to appear in court with the minor [C.R.S. 42-4-1716(4)(a)(I)].</p>
