Rebuilt Title Established by Salvage Title Checklist
C.R.S. 42-4-201–234, 42-6-102 (16), 42-6-136 (2) 42-6-206

The following steps must be completed when repairs have been made to a salvage title vehicle to obtain a roadworthy title. The title will be branded "Rebuilt from Salvage."

Step	What You Need To Do	Forms/Fees
1	Complete the Salvage Title Statement of Fact.	DR 2424
2	Sign the statement on the face of the Salvage Title certifying that the vehicle is roadworthy, pursuant to C.R.S. 42-4-201 through 42-4-234.	
3	<p>The applicant shall stamp into the motor vehicle the words "REBUILT FROM SALVAGE", with each letter being not less than one-fourth inch in size. Such words should be stamped in the following locations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Motorcycle — on the frame in a visible location. • Class A Motor Home — on the main entrance doorjamb. • Trailer — adjacent to the public vehicle identification number. • All other motor vehicles — on the body post to which the driver's door latches, also known as the driver's door B pillar, pursuant to C.R.S. 42-6-136 (3)(b)(II). 	
4	<p>Have the motor vehicle inspected and a Certified VIN Inspection form (DR 2704) completed by a P.O.S.T. certified inspector. Your local county motor vehicle office can refer you to a P.O.S.T. certified inspector in your area.</p> <p>➔ Inspection must not be over one (1) year old</p> <p>Some of the items the certified inspector will check are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Lights • Tires and Wheels • Mirrors • Windshield and Wipers • Sufficient horsepower to operate with the normal flow of traffic • All parts must be permanently attached by welding, brackets or bolts • Seat(s) permanently attached • No torn or jagged metal • "Rebuilt from Salvage" stamped on vehicle <p>If an Assigned VIN is required by the certified inspector, follow the Colorado Assigned Vehicle Identification Checklist (DR 2709).</p>	<p>DR 2704 DR 2709 Inspection Fee— \$20.00</p>
5	<p>Apply for a Certificate of Title at the county motor vehicle office in the county in which you live. Secure and verifiable identification (SVID) is required to obtain a title or registration in the state of Colorado.</p> <p>The county may request to see your receipts for major parts used in repair.</p>	<p>DR 2424 DR 2704 DR 2709 Salvage Title</p>
