

Dana Shea-Reid has been Director of the State Personnel Board since October, 2012 and also served as a Board member for 5 years, having been appointed by Governor Bill Ritter. She was vice-chair for three years and completed her term in June 30, 2012.

Ms. Shea-Reid has more than twenty years of management experience in public sector human resources with Colorado municipalities. Since 2002 she has also provided administrative and human resources consulting services to public sector and nonprofit employers through her consultancy, Shea Resources, LLC. At the federal level her experience included a three year contract with the U.S. Department of Labor Office of Workers Compensation. In the nonprofit sector, she was contracted to build, from the ground-up, a complete HR function for a Denver-based start up of a national nonprofit organization and was later asked to serve as its Chief Human Resources and Employment Officer which she did for two years prior to her appointment as Board Director.

Ms. Shea-Reid has a Master's in Nonprofit Management from Regis University and attended the University of Colorado-Denver Graduate School of Public Affairs completing 3 years of graduate studies in public administration. She earned her Bachelor's degree from the University of New Mexico.
