### BILL REQUESTS AND GENERAL SESSION DEADLINE FOR:

<i>December 1, 2015 (Tuesday)</i>	Members to request bills. Members may not introduce more than five bills. Of the five bills, excluding appropriations and interim bills, not more than two bills may be requested after December 1.	Pre-session
<i>January 8 (Friday)</i>	Filing one of each member's three bills requested prior to December 1 with the house of introduction for printing, distribution to Legislative Council Staff for preparation of fiscal notes, and introduction on the 1st day.	Pre-session
<i>January 13 (Wednesday)</i> <b>General Assembly Convenes</b>	Introducing bills required to be filed 5 days prior to the 1st day and bills to increase the <b>number of judges</b> .	1st Day
<i>January 15 (Friday)</i>	Introducing the two remaining <b>Senate bills</b> requested prior to December 1.	3rd Day
<i>January 19 (Tuesday)</i>	Introducing the two remaining <b>House bills</b> requested prior to December 1 and for submitting remaining bill requests to the Office of Legislative Legal Services.	7th Day
<i>January 29 (Friday)</i>	Introducing <b>Senate bills</b> , except for supplemental appropriation bills recommended by the Joint Budget Committee and the Long Bill.	17th Day
<i>February 3 (Wednesday)</i>	Introducing <b>House bills</b> , except for supplemental appropriation bills recommended by the Joint Budget Committee and the Long Bill.	22nd Day
<i>February 8 (Monday)</i>	Introducing <b>supplemental appropriation bills</b> recommended by the Joint Budget Committee.	27th Day
<i>March 2 (Wednesday)</i>	Final passage of <b>Senate bills</b> in the Senate and <b>House bills</b> in the House.*	50th Day
<i>March 11 (Friday)</i>	Final passage of any bill that increases the <b>number of judges</b> .	59th Day
<i>March 28 (Monday)</i>	Introducing the <b>Long Bill</b> in the House.	76th Day
<i>April 1 (Friday)</i>	Final passage of the <b>Long Bill</b> in the House.	80th Day
<i>April 4 (Monday)</i>	Final passage in the Senate of <b>House bills</b> .*	83rd Day
<i>April 8 (Friday)</i>	Final passage of the <b>Long Bill</b> in the Senate.	87th Day

<i>April 11 (Monday)</i>	Final passage in the House of all <b>Senate bills</b> .*	90th Day
	Deadline to introduce resolutions and memorials.	
<i>April 15 (Friday)</i>	Adoption of the conference committee report on the <b>Long Bill</b> .	94th Day
	Final passage in house of introduction of all bills creating statutory committees with legislative members.	
<i>April 21 (Thursday)</i>	Introducing bills.	100th Day
<i>April 22 (Friday)</i>	Final passage in house of introduction of all bills referred to the Appropriations Committee in that house.	101st Day
	Final passage, including any conference committee report, for any school finance bills.	
<i>May 5 (Thursday)</i>	Final passage in second house of all bills referred to Appropriations Committee in that house.	114th Day
<i>May 9 (Monday)</i>	Reconvene for adjournment sine die if there has been adjournment to a day certain, unless the joint resolution for adjournment to a day certain specifies another day for reconvening.	118th Day
<i>May 11 (Wednesday)</i>	<b>Adjournment sine die.</b>	120th Day

<i>January 12 (Tuesday)</i>	Joint committees to meet with state departments to review performance plans, regulatory agendas, and budget requests. The meetings are to occur between November 1 and the start of the session.	Pre-session
<i>February 10 (Wednesday)</i>	Committees to meet with the Joint Budget Committee to review department budget priorities.	29th Day
<i>February 11 (Thursday)</i>	House committees to report House bills introduced on or before the 7th legislative day, other than the House Appropriations Committee.	30th Day
<i>February 18 (Thursday)</i>	Senate committees to report Senate bills, other than the Senate Appropriations Committee.	37th Day
<i>February 25 (Thursday)</i>	House committees to report remaining House bills, other than the House Appropriations Committee.	44th Day
<i>March 25 (Friday)</i>	Committees to report bills originating in the other house, other than the Appropriations Committees and Legislative Council.	73rd Day
<i>April 8 (Friday)</i>	Committees in the house of introduction, including the Appropriations Committee, to report bills creating statutory committees with legislative members.	87th Day
<i>April 15 (Friday)</i>	Appropriations Committee in house of introduction to report referred bills.	94th Day
<i>April 22 (Friday)</i>	Committees in the second house to report bills creating statutory committees with legislative members to the Legislative Council.	101st Day
<i>April 28 (Thursday)</i>	Committees in the second house to report bills referred to the Appropriations Committee in that house.	107th Day
<i>April 29 (Friday)</i>	Legislative Council to report bills.	108th Day
<i>May 2 (Monday)</i>	Appropriations Committee in second house to report bills.	111th Day

### INTERIM STUDIES, DEADLINE FOR:

<i>April 15 (Friday)</i>	Submitting written requests to the Legislative Council for interim studies.	94th Day
<i>April 21 (Thursday)</i>	Legislative Council Director of Research to submit to the Legislative Council Executive Committee the number of interim committee meetings that may be held.	100th Day
<i>April 29 (Friday)</i>	Legislative Council to meet to review and prioritize requests from legislative members for interim studies.	108th Day
