Arvada Police Chief, Don Wick, of Arvada represents the law enforcement member on the commission from the 7th Congressional District for a term expiring July 1, 2017.

Chief Wick has been the Chief of Police for the City of Arvada for 8 years and brings 34 years of law enforcement experience to the Gaming Commission. Prior to his position as Chief of Police, Chief Wick served in various positions ranging from Police Officer, Sergeant, Commander, and Deputy Chief with the City of Arvada, starting in 1985. While serving in those positions, Chief Wick worked in police operations, investigations, emergency management, and administration. Chief Wick also worked as a police officer with the Laramie Police Department in Laramie, Wyoming starting in 1981.

Chief Wick serves as a board member for The Jefferson Foundation. He previously served as a board member on the Colorado Association of Chiefs of Police and was the Association's President from 2010-2011. Chief Wick has also served as a board member for organizations such as the Center for Public Safety, Northwestern University, the Ralston House, and the Arvada Jefferrson Kiwanis Club. He was the Executive Director for the Arvada Child Advocacy Center.

He holds a Master of Business Administration from the University of Denver and a Master of Public Administration from the University of Denver.
