



WHY? Colorado Shines

Points Structure

- Levels 1 and 2 are building blocks to quality, and managed by our team of licensing specialists
- Levels 3-5 are a points system that also includes an assessor evaluation and a minimum of points to be earned and will be managed by the contracted ratings administrator, with oversight by the Office of Early Childhood's QRIS Manager



What is the PDIS?




The Professional Development Information System (PDIS) is a web-based system supporting career & professional development for Colorado's early childhood workforce.

Description of Trend:


Performance has steadily increased since July 2015.
