

Acceptable Electronic Formats for Data Exhibits

The Water Quality Control Commission's Procedural Rules, Regulation #21 (5 CCR 1002-21) states at 21.E.2.b.ii that:

“Where a party's or any governmental entity's position or proposal in a hearing is based in part on analysis of water quality data, the party or governmental entity shall submit its analysis of the data and a description of the data upon which the analysis is based, but is not required to submit the raw data into the hearing record. However, the party or governmental entity shall provide an electronically manipulable copy of its data to the Division and any party that requests it. If the Division or any party or governmental entity chooses to submit some or all of the data into the hearing record, the data exhibit may be provided in any electronic format that is on a list maintained by the Commission Office, notwithstanding the requirement to submit the prehearing statement in PDF format as specified above.”

This is the list of acceptable electronic formats for data exhibits.

1. PDF (Portable Document File)
2. Microsoft Office Excel File (*.xls or *.xlsx)

PLEASE NOTE that all submittals other than data exhibits are to be submitted in PDF format.
