

Role of Procurement During the Disaster

- * Pre-Disaster
 - * On Call and other “emergency” contracts
 - * Debris removal, lodging, large equipment and labor rates for operators
 - * Purchasing Cards
 - * Training for EOC
 - * FEMA, FHWA Familiarity
 - * Provision in purchasing rules to allow for emergency purchases
- * During Disaster
 - * EOC
 - * Resource for resources
 - * Be available

Recovery: Infrastructure & Facilities

Projects Underway

- * Raw water supply lines – Bypass, Pipelines
- * Roadway construction to Button Rock Reservoir
- * Irrigation ditch diversions
- * Water treatment plant – Minor site work
- * Sewer lines damaged in flood
- * Wastewater treatment plant – Significant work
- * Bridge Repairs
- * Damaged park and greenway facilities

Purchase of Royal Mobile Home Park

- Half of park in future St. Vrain River channel
- Discussions to purchase underway prior to flood
- Funded by 2014 storm water fee increase
- City staff assisting residents in obtaining max FEMA funds
- Residents being offered relocation benefits



- St.Vrain Greenway (except between Harvest Junction east to Hwy 119)
- Left Hand Creek Greenway (except from Rec Cntr. to Hwy 119, Lefthand Park to Sunset, some along Missouri)



Where Are We?

Total Damage Estimate	\$152 million
Total Purchase Orders to date	\$5.7 million

Still to Do:

- Reestablish City's water diversions from the St. Vrain
- Continued planning and analysis of River Corridor
- Remove granular debris and trees from creeks
- Commence with Major Bridge Replacements
- Rebuild the Greenways
- Initiate Major River Flood Control Projects
