340B Drug Payment in EAPGs (Slide 8, Time 00:06:58-00:08:30)

- Changing the UD modifier discount percentage from 50% to 20% (payment will use 80% of EAPG Weight)
- State Plan Amendment submitted on March 31st
 - The Department in conversations with CMS
 - March 11, 2018 Effective Date

Colorado Rule Change (Slide 9, Time 00:08:30-00:10:01)

- Rule update posted on [Outpatient Hospital Payment](#) page

- A temporary emergency rule was approved on March 9th
- Permanent rule will be presented to the Medical Services Board on May 11th

- Additional non-specific language to accommodate implementation of potential rate change closer to effective date

Drug Payment in EAPGs (Slide 10, Time 00:10:01-00:12:14)

- Next steps include researching specific ways of carving out drugs from EAPGs

EAPG Grouper Version Update (Slides 11-12, Time 00:12:14-00:15:53)

- 3M released new grouper version on 3/28/2018
 - Active in DXC system as of 4/5/2018
- **Agency Values Updated – incorrect 340B Discount**
 - 3M fixed in April Service Pack
 - No claims processed using incorrect settings
- 4/1/2018 Updates to CPT/HCPCS code-sets
 - No claims impacted
- **Service Pack 2 Release on May 17th**
 - Will add revenue code 0910 to non-covered list effective for EAPGs 10/31/2016 regardless of service date
 - Claim data has shown this revenue code is not billed, therefore no claims were mispriced
 - Redistributed Charges for “lower of”

Mass Adjustment Updates (Slides 13-14, Time 00:15:53-00:18:41)

- DXC has reprocessed ~370k claims
 - EAPG claims processed in legacy MMIS
 - Most claims finished as of 5/4 financial cycle
- Distinct Procedure Modifier claims
 - 493 claims adjusted – were included in 4/27 financial cycle
- Error 2580 Claims
 - Logic updated – required adjustment of 5,076 outpatient hospital claims with erroneous payments

- Claims which should not have been paid originally were reprocessed and denied in 4/27 financial cycle

Legacy Claim Analysis (Slide 15, Time 00:18:41-00:21:49)

- 6.7% of reprocessed claims resulted in Suspense
- Common reasons for denial / suspense:
 - Attending Provider ID Missing (EOB 1390)
 - Physical Therapy / Occupational Therapy Denials (EOB 1022)
- Zero pay / Low payments on claims
 - Check if lines with revenue code 450 or 360 are coded with CPT/HCPCs

Mass Adjustment Updates (Slide 16, Time 00:21:49-00:22:15)

- 340B Claims
 - Once system is configured and all authorities obtained, mass adjustment will be performed
 - Effective date March 11, 2018
 - Do not have accurate claim volume estimates

Ongoing Issues (Slide 17, Time 00:22:15-00:39:58)

- Multiple Visits / Same Day Claims
 - Duplicate payment auditing logic looks for same EAPG, same client, same DOS on claim
 - How can the Department know from the claim that visit was distinct?
- Modifier 26/TC Reporting Requirement
 - Based on feedback earlier this morning this is currently being reviewed and will be clarified in near future
