Invitation to Bid

The Board of Phillips County Commissioners will be receiving sealed bids at their office in the Phillips County Courthouse, 221 S. Interocean Avenue, Holyoke, CO 80734 up to 10:00 a.m. on July 19, 2013 at which time they will be opened and read aloud considering the following:

Phillips County Enhancement Project

Phillips County is working to complete Enhancement Project No. STE C370-011 (Project Code 18769) at the Phillips County Fairgrounds immediately adjoining U.S. Highway 385 at the north edge of Holyoke, Colorado.

CDOT has determined that the Underutilized Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (UDBE's) goal for this project is "0". The project is exempt from Davis-Bacon wage rates because it is not on a highway right-of-way. On-the-Job-Training goal is "0" also.

The CDOT Form 347, Certification of EEO Compliance, is no longer required to be submitted in the bid package. This form certified that the contractor/proposed subcontractors were in compliance with the Joint Reporting Committee EEO-1 form requirements. The EEO-1 Report must still be submitted to the Joint Reporting Committee if the contractors and subcontractors meet the eligibility requirements (29CFR 1602.7); we will, however, no longer require certification. The Phillips Enhancement Project includes the following major items of work:

(Other items listed in the plans will be done by Force Account by Phillips County).

The two major components may be done independently. Each component will need to be completed in forty (40) working days once a "Notice to Proceed" is issued for the component. Any landscaping contractors proposing to complete the water feature must be pre-qualified. To pre-qualify, contact Randy Schafer as instructed below. If weather becomes an issue, the County can suspend the project until weather conditions permit continuation. All bids need to be submitted in a sealed envelope marked "Phillips County Fairgrounds Enhancement Project". Bidders must include bid security in the amount of 5% of their bid.
