

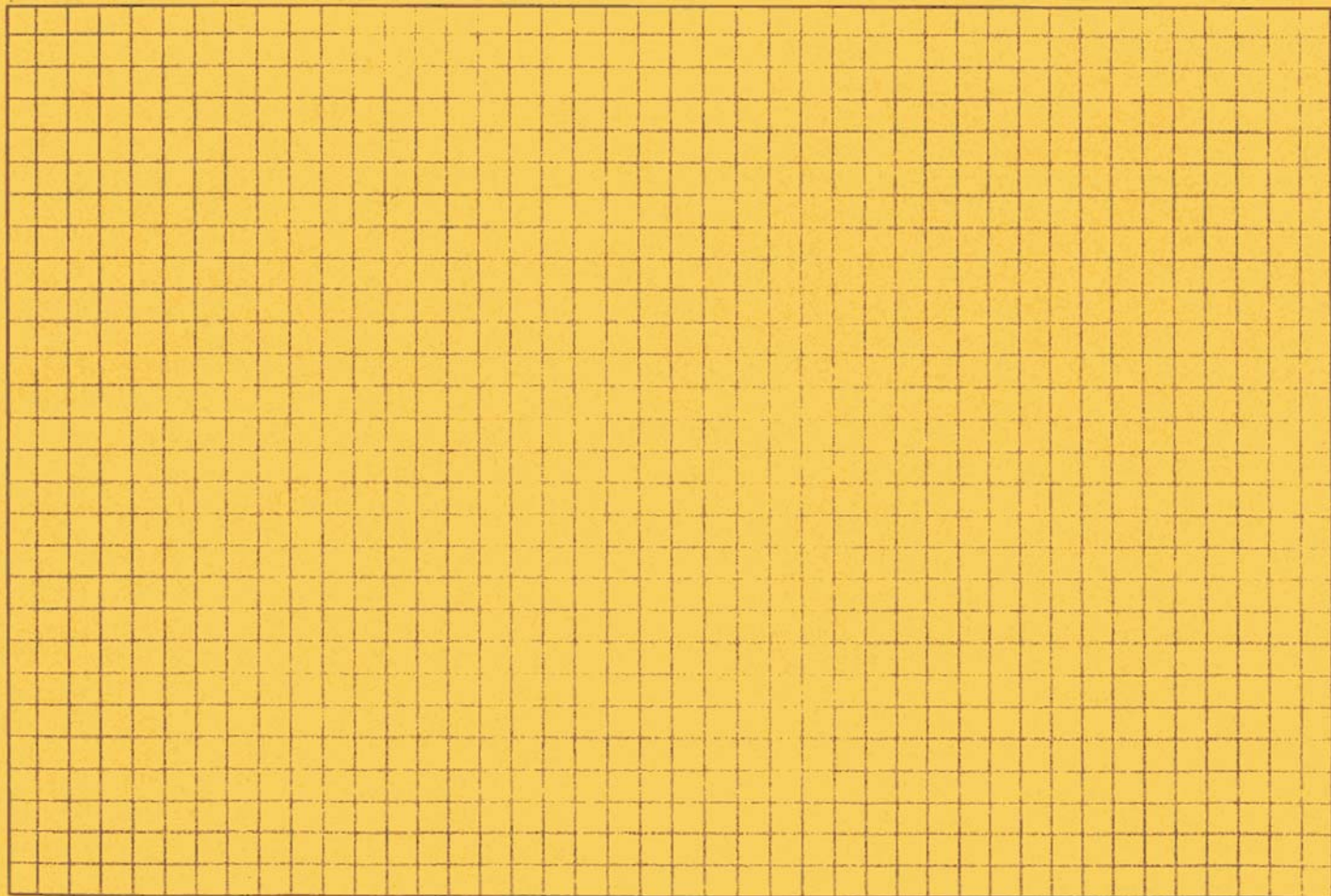


PLAN AND PRACTICE A FIRE EXIT DRILL

TO GET EVERYONE OUT OF YOUR HOME SAFELY AND QUICKLY, YOU NEED TO KNOW AT LEAST TWO WAYS OUT OF EACH ROOM IN CASE OF FIRE.

1. Draw a floor plan of your home below. Include all doors, windows, stairways, porches and porch roofs.
2. Figure out two ways to reach the ground safely from each room, especially from each bedroom. Make sure all windows can be opened from the inside.
3. Arrange a place for all who live in your home to meet at a pre-established meeting place outside.
4. Hold a fire drill at least every six months.
5. Finally, the number to call for an emergency is 911. If you suspect fire, get out first and call 911 from your neighbor's house.
