DRESS CODE:

Dress Code is required for all classes. An appropriate cover-up should be worn entering and leaving the dance space. Do not wear dance shoes outside of class, this keeps dance floor clean and protects shoes from rough surfaces.

- All Classes: Hair must be secured off the neck. Jewelry is not permitted except for stud earrings.
- Ballet: Black or pink leotard with pink tights. Pink leather or canvas ballet technique shoes. Dance skirt is optional. Warm layer may be worn during barre work. Hair in a bun is ideal.
- Tap: Clothing that allows the teacher to see the lines of the body. Students ages 3-11: Black flat "Mary-Jane" tap shoes with bow. Students 12 and up: black flat tap oxfords with ties
- Creative Dance: Leotard and tights of any color. Leather or canvas ballet technique shoes. Dance skirt is optional.

TUITION:

Tuition remains the same whether it is a long (5-week) or short (3-week) month, regardless of absences. If you are experiencing financial difficulties, please call. We do not want to deny any child an opportunity to dance if a viable solution is available.

SNOW DAYS/CANCELLATIONS:

Snow days and cancellations will be posted on the Creede Parks & Rec facebook page. A complimentary email will also be sent for anyone interested.

MISSED CLASSES/REFUNDS:

Fees are not prorated for missed classes or holidays and there will be no refunds for classes missed. Once you register for the year and have reserved your place in a space limited class, you are obligated to see through the financial commitment of the full term. If the teacher cancels a class for any reason, then class will be made up at a later date. If a student must miss class, discuss make-up class options with the teacher.

GENERAL RULES:

- Observation is prohibited during class unless special arrangements have been made. Remember, it may not distract your child for you to be in the class, but it is very distracting to other children who do not know you.
- Please arrive on time. All children should use the bathroom prior to class. We cannot guarantee supervision of a child picked up late from class. If you are running late, please contact Parks & Rec as soon as possible.
- Students should arrive dressed according to the dress code and with the necessary hair accessories and shoes. Students' names should be on every item, especially dance shoes. Students who are not adequately prepared or late to class due to a lack of preparation will observe class only.
- Parks & Rec will assume no responsibility for lost or misplaced items.
- No Food or Drink No food or drink (with the exception of bottled water) is allowed in the dance space. Food and drinks are allowed in the lobby however, any damages made are the responsibility of the child and that child's parents.
- Class will be dismissed by the teacher. If class started late, it may run late. If a student needs to be excused for any reason during class, they must ask permission of the teacher. Students should remain in the building until parents arrive to pick them up.
- Parks & Rec does not carry medical insurance for its students. It is required that all dance students be covered by their own family insurance policies and if injury occurs it is understood that the student's own policy is your only source of reimbursement.
