4. Incentive Performance Measure Qualifier One

- Should place of service 72 be added to the incentive measures scope document?
- Has the standard/incentive measures scope documents been compared to Amendment 7 and the coding manual to ensure that the correct ranges are listed?
- Indicators 1 and 2 (MH Engagement)/Update language in Step 2 to "Exclude members *without* a negative diagnosis history"?
- Indicator 9 (Documented Care Coordination Agreements/how is the Department defining MOU in this context, what are the expectations for

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“Updated BHO care coordination plans”, what is the expectation for the “status update regarding care coordination participation between partners”, and what is meant by “participation records”?

6. The FY 16/17 Experience of Care and Health Outcomes (ECHO) Survey

Christian Kolstonski and **Russell Kennedy** (HCPF) will review the latest survey results.

7. BHO monthly and quarterly reports sent by the Department

James Bloom (HCPF) will lead this discussion with BHO quality staff to understand pharmacy data needs and address these questions:

- Can foster care data be shared monthly?
- File formats and expected delivery: Should BHOs anticipate one large file for the backlogged data, or monthly files (a file for March, a file for April, etc.)?
- Should BHOs anticipate a 2-month lag of submissions like we’ve seen previously?
- Specific to pharmacy data – will BHOs have that data in time to complete the performance measures that use pharmacy data? If this doesn’t seem feasible, what is the game plan for reporting those particular measures?
- Status on getting foster care data?
- What measures are the BHOs needing SUD data for? What type of SUD data?
