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**Findings and Notice of Adoption
Colorado Auto Industry Division
Schedule of Fees and Charges**

Michael S. Hartman, Executive Director of the Colorado Department of Revenue, State Licensing Authority ("the Department"), does hereby make such findings and take such actions as are authorized and required by section 12-6-123, C.R. S. and as may be further authorized by the provisions of the Colorado Automobiles Code ("Code"), article 6 of title 12, C.R.S., regarding establishing such fees and charges as are necessary for the proper regulation and control of the administration, enforcement, and issuance or denial of the licensing of buyer agents, distributors, manufacturer representatives, and motor vehicle manufacturers.

The Executive Director makes the following findings:

1. The Department has considered the services to be offered by the Department as required under the provisions of the Code, the direct and indirect costs reasonably to be borne by the Department for providing those services, the beneficiaries of those services and the revenues produced by those paying fees and charges as it pertains to automobile business licensing.
2. The Department desires to establish a schedule of fees and charges to recover the full direct and indirect costs reasonably borne for providing the services required by the Code and any Department rules promulgated thereunder, such that general taxes are not diverted from general services of a broad nature and thereby utilized to unfairly and inequitably subsidize the services to be provided by the Department.
3. A schedule of fees and charges to be paid by those requesting and utilizing such services needs to be adopted so that the Department might carry into effect the provisions of the Code and any rules promulgated by the Department pursuant to the Code.
4. Adoption of this schedule of fees and charges is necessary in order to comply with state law and the preservation of the economic and social welfare, and the health, peace, and morals of the people of Colorado.
5. The Department has reviewed the schedule of fees and charges set forth below, and finds that the schedule reflects the actual direct and indirect costs of the Department in the administration and enforcement of the Code, so that the fees and charges when added to other fees transferred to the Auto Dealers License Fund should meet relevant statutory requirements.
6. At least annually as required by the Code, the Department shall review the amounts of the fees and charges and, if necessary, adjust the amounts to reflect the direct and indirect costs of the Department.

7. At the Motor Vehicle Dealer Board Meeting held April 17, 2018, the Board recommended a 12% fee increase, based on a projected 0% growth in licensing activity, with the following exceptions:

- a. Continuation of the Reprint Fee at \$25
- b. Continuation of the Late Fee at \$50

Furthermore, at the May 15, 2018 meeting the Board recommended the following for the off-premise permits:

- c. Class One – Limited Sales Activity Off-Premise Permit at \$200
- d. Class Two – Full Sales Activity Off-Premise Permit at \$500

NOW, THEREFORE, the Department does hereby ADOPT the schedule of fees and charges set forth as follows and to be effective on the dates indicated:
