

## Estes Park Indoor Golf League

### **League Details**

Teams will consist of 2 players per team. Each team will play a 6-week league schedule against one opposing team each week. League matches consist of 9 holes at one of our 15 different courses each week. Teams must play their matches in each league week. Saturday is the beginning of each league week. Teams must confirm they have scheduled their weekly match with their opponent with league commissioner Austin Logan. Match play for all games. Tee times will be in 2-hour blocks per match. ### **League Play**

- January 19, 2019 through February 23, 2019 **(Mandatory meet and greet January 12, 2019)**
- \$50 entry per team, includes, entry to Estes Valley Community Center and prize pot.
- 9 holes best net ball based on current handicap. Players with no handicap will be given an accurate handicap during meet and greet

\*If you are not a member of EVCC or Silver Sneakers, practice rounds outside of your match will be your responsibility

\*A reminder that simulator reservations are charged in 2-hour increments. All matches should be completed in that time frame.

### **Simulator Rules**

- All players must wash their ball and clubs prior to each round. Any dirt on either will transfer to the screen. If you do not have a clean ball, we will have some for you to use.
- No cleats may be worn while using the simulator. Tennis shoes or gym shoes work fine.
- No food or drink in the hitting area.
- Only hit from the designated hitting area.
- Players under 13 are permitted, but their teammate must be legal parent or guardian.

### **Handicapping**

- Handicap will be based on current GHIN if applicable, non-handicap players will be assigned a handicap based on general ability to be determined at meet-and-greet.
- After all players have an established handicap, the schedule of matches will be released. and number of divisions will be determined after the final number of teams is established.
- Handicaps are based on league rounds only.

### **Teams**

- Teams will be made up of two players.
- Each team will play one 9-hole round per week. League rounds may be played at any time but must be completed by the deadline provided. Example: week 1 matches begin January 19, 2018; week 1 matches must be complete at some point between Saturday January 19th and Friday January 25th. Weeks will run from Saturday- Friday
- One substitute is permitted per team, but that substitute may not participate on any other team within the league.

**Matches**

- (1) 9-hole match will be scheduled each week.
- Players can play as far as 2 rounds ahead. Example: Gregory needs to go out of town and will not be able to play a match. Gregory and his partner may play their next two opponents if possible, ahead of time and remain on schedule.

**Match Reporting**

- You are required to write your score down on a score card. Scorecards will be available in the simulator room each week. You will be required to report the outcome of your match to Austin Logan at [Austin@golfestes.com](mailto:Austin@golfestes.com)

**Mulligans**

- Tracking errors will happen. All members of both teams must agree that a shot was mis-read to permit a mulligan. Be honest with yourself, playing partners, and competitors.

**Match Play**

- Each team will consist of an A player and a B player. The lower net score of player A and B will be counted in the match vs the other team.
- There is no putting. Each group is responsible for enter putts manually via "Player Decides"
  - 6' or less = 1 putt
  - 6'1" to 35' = 2 putts
  - 35'1" or greater = 3 putt
- A maximum Score for any hole is a triple bogey
- USGA rules of golf apply within golf simulator i.e. ball in water, out of bounds, unplayable.

**Other Important Items**

- Please be aware that movement near the tracks while the simulator is prepared to register a shot can cause a false shot. Mulligans will be applicable in this case.
- To prevent this from happening, please be prompt in retrieving your ball or pick the ball up with your hand when going to retrieve it instead of dragging the ball back across the tracks with a club.
- In order to uphold the fairness of the league, this will be left to the discretion of league administrators.

Proper etiquette and sportsmanship must be demonstrated at all times.

**Prizes**

- Prize pool will vary depending on the size of the league.
- League rules are subject to change and final decision by Austin Logan
