




House Bill 14-1366 Mandates

- ▶ Convene a work group by August 1, 2014
- ▶ Report to Legislative committees no later than February 1, 2015 recommendations
- ▶ Promulgate rules by January 1, 2016




House Bill 14-1366: Declaration

- ▶ Edibles should not be marketed to anyone under the age of 21
- ▶ Protect from unintentional ingestion
- ▶ Readily identifiable to general public




House Bill 14-1366 On Product Indicators

- ▶ Edibles should be clearly identifiable, when practicable
 - Using a standard symbol
 - Indicating product contains marijuana
 - Not for consumption by children




Guiding Principles–Rule Development

- ▶ **Transparent**
 - Rules clearly articulate expectations of Licensees
 - Licensee operations open for inspection/monitoring
- ▶ **Systematic**
 - Rules leverage technology
 - Planned, methodical, repeatable
- ▶ **Operability**
 - Ability to integrate into current business processes
 - Ability to be monitored and enforced by MED
- ▶ **Defensible**

- ▶ 10 mg Edibles
- ▶ Scoring of product
- ▶ Easily separable
