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Purpose and Audience:

The purpose of this Informational Memo is to announce the conclusion of the [Senate Bill \(SB\) 19-238](#) Training Advisory Committee and publication of the Committee's recommendations. The Training Advisory Committee was charged with reviewing training and enforcement of training per SB 19-238. The report will be publicly available to the Health and Human Services Committee of the Colorado Senate, the Public Health and Human Services Committee of the Colorado House of Representatives, and the Colorado Joint Budget Committee, or any successor committees.

Information:

On May 28, 2019 Governor Polis signed SB 19-238 into law. The bill required the Departments of Health Care Policy & Financing and Public Health & Environment to consult with stakeholders "to establish a process for reviewing and enforcing initial and ongoing training requirements" for home care agency employees.

The Department of Health Care Policy & Financing (Department) announced the selection of sixteen members to the Training Advisory Committee at the end of

September 2019. This Committee served for a period of three months and concluded their work in December 2019.
