The Department has received the Participant Directed Programs Policy Collaborative's (PDPPC) recommendation to reinstate Funds for Additional Services (FAS) for the Consumer Directed Attendant Support Services (CDASS) service delivery option.

The Department recognizes the benefits of allowing more flexible spending for goods and services that promote inclusion in the community, increase safety in the home environment, and decrease the need for other Medicaid services.
