 HB 1294 DATA REGARDING ELIGIBILITY FOR EXTENDED SURVEY CYCLE
 July 23, 2013

What does eligible for extended survey cycle mean?

A facility is eligible to be put on a 36 month survey cycle if during the 3 year look back period from the most recent survey if the facility has:

- ✓ Been licensed for 3 years
- ✓ No change of ownership in past 3 years
- ✓ No conditional license
- ✓ No enforcement action
- ✓ No significant deficiency from a complaint (C level or above)
- ✓ No pattern of deficient practice (see attached grouping of tags for definition of pattern)

What does ineligible for extended survey cycle mean?

A facility is ineligible for the 36 month survey cycle if the facility meets one or more of the criteria specified above. These facilities will be surveyed on 24 month cycle; however, facilities that are excluded from the extended survey for multiple reasons may be surveyed in shorter interval.
