

Land Disposal Restrictions (LDR) Checklist for Hazardous Waste Generators

- **Have you determined all hazardous waste codes that apply to your waste?**
 - o Use Colorado Hazardous Waste Regulations 6 CCR 1007-3 Part 261.
 - o Include listed wastes (F, K, U, and P) and characteristics (ignitability, corrosivity, reactivity and toxicity).
- **If your waste is an F001 through F005 or F039 listed waste, have you identified the constituent(s) of concern that caused the waste to be in this listing?**
- **If your waste is a characteristic waste, have you determined if it has underlying hazardous constituents (UHCs) above the universal treatment standards (UTS)?**
 - o 6 CCR 1007-3 Section 268.40 specifies when UHCs have to be identified and Section 268.48 identifies the UHCs along with the universal treatment standards.
 - o You need only identify those UHCs which can reasonably be expected to be present.
 - Use your knowledge of the raw materials used, the process, and potential reaction products of the process or
 - Use the results of a one-time analysis for the entire list of constituents.
- **Is your waste a wastewater or a nonwastewater?**
 - o A wastewater contains less than 1% total organic carbon AND less than 1% total suspended solids.
- **Do the waste codes that apply to your waste have a sub-category?**
 - 6 CCR 1007-3 Section 268.40 identifies waste codes with sub-categories.
- **Are alternative treatment standards available for your waste because it consists of contaminated debris, contaminated soil, a lab pack or High Temperature Metals Recovery (HTMR) residues?**

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- **Does your waste meet any or all of the applicable treatment standards?**
 - If your waste is both listed and characteristic, the waste must meet both treatment standards.
 - Sometimes the treatment standard for the listing may also address the characteristic.
- **Have you treated your waste to meet one or more of these standards?**
- **Have you included the appropriate certification to let the treatment, storage or disposal facility know what to do with this waste? Have you signed the certification?**
 - 6 CCR 1007-3 Section 268.7 identifies notification, certification and recordkeeping requirements for generators.
 - Certify your waste doesn't meet the required treatment standards.
 - Certify your waste does meet the required treatment standards.
 - Certify your waste meets some, but not all, of the required treatment standards.
 - Certify your waste meets an alternative treatment standard.
 - Certify your waste is eligible for an alternative treatment standard, but does not currently meet the standard.
- **Have you included a copy of the LDR notification and certification with your hazardous waste shipping manifest? Have you kept a copy?**
- **Your hazardous waste service provider (consultant, transporter, or Treatment, Storage and Disposal Facility) can assist you with this paperwork, but YOU - as the generator of the waste- are responsible for ensuring that accurate and complete information is provided on the LDR notification and hazardous waste manifest.**
