

TENTATIVE PART 19 RULEMAKING SCHEDULE

The following outlines the tentative rulemaking schedule/timeline for the proposed amendments to the Part 19 regulation (titled “Licenses and Radiation Safety Requirements for Irradiators”). April 10, 2016	Public comment period for Part 19 <u>ends</u> .
