

TENTATIVE PART 21 RULEMAKING SCHEDULE

The following outlines the tentative rulemaking schedule/timeline for the proposed Part 21 regulation (titled “Colorado Low Income Radon Mitigation Assistance (LIMA) Program”). Note that this schedule is subject to change and interested stakeholders should periodically refer back to the radiation program website for updated information.

June 10, 2016	Public comment period for Part 21 rule begins.

Mid-December 2016	Estimated effective date for Part 21 regulation.
