Licensees/employees of licensees should verify the information by calling the agency prior to going to any law enforcement office to obtain fingerprints. Not all agencies performing fingerprinting are listed/represented.

City of Boulder, Colorado – Police Department

Charges for fingerprinting are \$10 per card.

Fingerprints are only done during certain hours and days.

City of Brighton, Colorado– Police Department

Charges for fingerprinting are \$5 per card for residents within the city limits of Brighton. It is \$15 for non-residents.

Grand Junction, Colorado – Mesa County Sheriff's Office

The Mesa County Sheriff's Office provides fingerprinting for the public Monday through Friday from 8 A.M. until 1 P.M. and on Saturday and Sunday from 12 Noon to 5 P.M. There is a \$5 charge for one card. If additional prints are requested, a fee of \$2 per card, per person is charged.
