WASTE GREASE ANNUAL REGISTRATION PRORATED FEE POLICY

On December 31, 2011, the Solid and Hazardous Waste Commission adopted waste grease registration annual fees to cover the direct and indirect costs of administering the waste grease program. Effective January 30, 2012, all Waste Grease Transporters, Waste Grease Facilities, and Personal Users of Waste Grease Other than For Use as Biofuel are subject to the annual waste grease registration fees set forth in Section 1.7.5 of the Regulations Pertaining to Solid Waste Sites and Facilities, 6 CCR 1007-2.

The Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, Hazardous Materials and Waste Management Division (“the Division”) has listed the following scenarios where a prorated registration fee would qualify in lieu of the \$570 per vehicle fee for Waste Grease Transporters or the \$1140 fee for Waste Grease Facilities.

1. A new waste grease business that has not previously operated as a waste grease transporter or waste grease facility in Colorado;
2. A currently registered Waste Grease Transporter that adds an additional vehicle(s) to their waste grease transporter fleet;

The business/registrant is responsible for demonstrating to the Division why their business should receive a prorated fee. The Division will make the final determination if the business/registrant is eligible for the prorated fee.

The chart below lists the prorated annual registration fees for waste grease transporters and facilities for a registration time frame of July through June of the following year. The registration fees will be prorated on a quarterly basis only. The required registration materials (e.g., completed Waste Grease Certificate of Registration Application form (WG-1), current vehicle registration(s) (if applicable) and fee(s)) must be postmarked on or before the last day of each quarter to be eligible for that quarter’s prorated fee. For example, in order to be eligible for the 3rd Quarter prorated waste grease transporter fee of \$285 for one vehicle, the business/registrant will need to mail by March 31 the completed Form WG-1, a copy of the vehicle’s current registration and a check in the amount of \$285 for the vehicle.

Quarter (Months Included)	Transporter Fee (per vehicle)	Facility Fee
1 st Quarter: July, August, September	\$570 (no prorated fee)	\$1140 (no prorated fee)
2 nd Quarter: October, November, December	\$428	\$855
3 rd Quarter: January, February, March	\$285	\$570
4 th Quarter: April, May, June	\$143	\$285
