General Instructions Form R-90
Application for Renewal of Registration for Limited Scope Operator

The Colorado *Rules and Regulations Pertaining to Radiation Control* (6 CCR 1007-1)(Regulations), requires that any person working as a Limited Scope X-Ray Operator in the State of Colorado must meet the requirements of Part 2, Section 2.6.1.4. Each Limited Scope Operator is required to maintain continuing education in radiologic technology. In most cases, training approved by the American Society of Radiologic Technologists (ASRT) will be accepted. The renewal application is used to submit your proof of continuing education so that your LSO registration may be renewed. The renewal application should be submitted 30 days before your expiration date so that you receive your new certificate before your current certificate expires.

All information requested on Form R-90 must be filled out completely.

Evidence and documentation of 24 hours of continuing education must be attached with the Form R-90 application. An application for renewal will not be processed unless documentation of at least 24 hours of continuing education has been submitted with registration.

The registration will expire and become void on the expiration date printed on the certificate.

A nonrefundable registration fee of \$60.00 must accompany the application. All applications must be filed with the proper attachments and paperwork along with the fee.

It is illegal for an LSO to continue operating an x-ray machine on living humans with an expired registration. Violation of this law may result in temporary or permanent loss of your registration.
