

Vonda Hall

In September 2013, Vonda Hall was elected to the State Personnel Board to complete a term vacated by former board member and chairman, Rich Djokic. Vonda's term will expire on June 30, 2016.

A retired attorney who served as Staff Attorney and General Counsel for the Colorado Association of Public Employees (CAPE) for 15 years and represented state employees in private practice until 2011, Vonda holds a Bachelor of Arts and a Master of Education degree from State University of New York at Buffalo and a Juris Doctor degree from the University of Cincinnati College of Law. She is a Fellow of the Urban Morgan Institute of Human Rights and was formerly a Board Member of Washington Park Community Center and the Rocky Mountain Headache Association.

Vonda successfully litigated pivotal cases for state employees, including Colorado Association of Public Employees v. Department of Highways, which prohibited contracting out without guidelines, and Department of Institutions v. Kinchen, which held that there must be just cause to discipline employees and the agency has the burden of proof.
