

How to do Business with CU Facilities Management (Boulder Campus)

The University of Colorado Procurement Service Center and CU Boulder Facilities Management Department invite interested vendors to attend a free information session on Monday, November 10. The session will be held on the Boulder campus in Room 235 of the University Memorial Center (UMC) from 1PM – 3PM. Space is limited and registration is required.
