RE: ICS Fee Schedule

Dear Respected Industry Partner:

The purpose of this letter is to inform you of the proposed Division of Inspection and Consumer Services (ICS) program fees to be effective January 1, 2015. A copy of the ICS fee schedule is attached.

This fee schedule is mainly unchanged from the FY 2013 Fee Schedule, except for the changes explained below.

The Anhydrous Ammonia Program site location category and \$125 fee has been replaced with a bulk tank category and a \$50 fee. This change will make the fee schedule more equitable, as the fee will now be assessed for each tank used at a location, instead of a single charge for the location.

The \$75 fee for a Farm Products Cash Buyer has been reduced to a \$25 fee. This is the same fee as a Farm Products Small Volume Dealer.

Because our fees have been very stable over the past several years, I am proposing that this fee schedule remain in effect until changed, as opposed to the past where a new fee schedule was established every fiscal year.

On September 17th, the Colorado Agricultural Commission members will vote to approve this fee schedule.
