**Industry-Wide Bulletin 14-08**

**RE: Contaminant Testing**

Dear Colorado Retail Marijuana Industry Members:

Pursuant to Industry Bulletin 14-06 released on June 30, 2014, MED adjusted the implementation schedule of beta testing, which has impacted the implementation of required contaminant testing. As a result, MED is adjusting the implementation requirements of Rule R 1501 while the Division continues to monitor testing capacities and results in order to ensure a conscientious and practicable rollout of the testing program. Once it is determined, MED will release an Industry Bulletin with information regarding the method and schedule of beta testing, as well as the transition into mandatory testing.

The Division continues to strongly encourage Retail Marijuana Establishments to submit samples to Retail Marijuana Testing Facilities for contaminant testing. Regarding rules R1502-1504, industry members should continue to reference Industry Bulletin 14-06.
