

**Logan County Commissioners Work Session**  
**July 24, 2018**

Present: Byron Pelton, Dave Donaldson, Joe McBride, Alan Samber, Valerie Richards, Lindsey Reeves, Marilee Johnson, Jeff Rice, Brian Kailey and Jennifer Crow.

Chairman Pelton called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM PREVIOUS SESSION** - Commissioner McBride moved to approve the minutes of the July 17, 2018 work session as written. Commissioner Donaldson seconded and the motion carried.

**REVIEW DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES (DHS) SCHEDULE OF BILLS** - Valerie Richards met with the Board to review the DHS schedule of bills dated July 24, 2018. The Board approved all bills as presented.

**REVIEW LOGAN COUNTY SCHEDULE OF BILLS** - Lindsey Reeves met with the Board to review the Logan County schedule of bills dated July 24, 2018. The Board approved all bills as presented.

**LOGAN COUNTY AMBULANCE COLLECTION ASSIGNMENTS** - Commissioner McBride moved to approve assignment of Logan County Ambulance debt collection accounts to Wakefield and Associates, the account numbers ending in 2007, 6001, 6035 and allow the Chairman to sign. Commissioner Donaldson seconded and the motion carried 3-0.

**COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS** - The Board reviewed and approved the Commissioners Proceedings, the publication of bills paid for the month of June, 2018.

**BI-ANNUAL SALARY PUBLICATION** - The Board reviewed and approved the publication of employee salaries as required by state statute to be published in August 2018 which is the June 2018 monthly gross salary for each employee.

**4-H FFA DEADLINE COMPLAINT** - Brian Kailey met with the Board to review complaints from parents of FFA Chapter members from Fleming. The FFA members will not be able to show their animals because of the missed deadline. Kailey explained all 4-H and FFA members are made aware of all deadlines in December.

Kailey also explained that families can decide whether they would like to receive the 4-H/FFA updates sent every Friday via e-mail or whether they want hard copies mailed to them. The weekly updates also remind everyone on all deadlines. Deadlines are also published in the monthly newsletter which is sent via e-mail or hard copy.

February 1 is the deadline to show livestock for the year. The next deadline for livestock is the weigh-in. The sheep and goat deadline is May 5 and these members did meet that deadline. The last deadline is the entries for county fair for 4-H and FFA on July 13. The families received information through e-mails a total of eight times before the deadline arrived. Both of the FFA members are older kids and one is a senior in high school. The kids also get the e-mails themselves. Two members out of 208 missed the deadlines.

Fleming FFA Advisor Mrs. Blake confirmed that she received the e-mails. Due to the missed deadline, the kids will not be allowed to show at the fair. They will still be required to complete their 4-H project by completing their record book.

The Fair Board approves the rules for the 4-H and FFA deadlines. The Board asked whether the Commissioners have any jurisdiction over the matter. Both Todd Thomas and Fair Board Livestock Chairman Aaron Hettinger have reviewed the complaint. The Livestock Committee has ruled that the members will not be able to show. The 4-H and FFA rules have always been strictly enforced and there has not been an exception made for over 30 years.

**REMEMBRANCE OF GENE MEISNER** - Commissioner Donaldson noted that today is the one year anniversary of former County Commissioner Gene Meisner's passing. Mr. Meisner served twelve years as commissioner and five or six years as Fair Manager.

**SIGN LOCATION LEASE SHOOTING SPORTS COMPLEX.** - The Commissioners recently signed a Sign Location Lease with the City of Sterling for the Logan County Shooting Sports Complex sign. Apparently the copy of the lease sent to the Commissioners for signature was not the final draft. The changes made are minimal. The Board will sign the new lease at the next business meeting.

There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned at 9:39 a.m.
