3a. Unfinished Business

a. Public Hearing for Papa’s Restaurant Report of Changes for current hotel and restaurant liquor license- City Manager Mike Patterson explained to council that Mr. Tom Bruno is looking to change his front and back premises in order to serve liquor in both of those areas. Mr. Patterson explained that Mr. Bruno does not want to start on front premises until our sidewalk code is passed, but would like to include it in the application so that he does not have to pay two separate fees.

Mr. Patterson explained that this is the same situation that happened with the Pour House. Council approved that liquor license while City Manager Mike Patterson and Matt Krob were out on an emergency. Mr. Paul will move forward with his premises with the understanding that he may have to change it if the sidewalk ordinance comes out with numbers that are different from what he has done. Mayor Ore opened the local liquor licensing board at 1:10 Councilor Villagrana verified that the meeting was a legal meeting and that it had been posted. Mr. Patterson explained that the meeting was legal. Mr. Patterson also discussed the importance in doing for one citizen what we would do for the next. Council discussed the report of changes in detail. Council confirmed that Mr. Bruno would not move forward with his change of premises in the front until the sidewalk code is finished. Council went out of the local liquor board at 1:21 p.m.

Mayor Ore opened the public hearing and Mr. Bruno discussed upcoming changes with the City Council. Mr. Bruno reiterated to council that he has no intentions on changing his front premises until the sidewalk code is finished. There were no comments from the public. Mayor Ore closed the public hearing. Councilor Baker moved to approve the report of changes for Papa’s
