

Optical Benefit

Good vision and healthy eyes are your keys to seeing the world around you.



Your optical benefit includes a credit that can be used toward the purchase of eyeglass lenses, frames, or contact lenses, once every 24 months.¹

Your entire credit must be used at the initial point of sale. Any part of your credit that is not used at the initial point of sale may not be saved and used later.

You can fill a prescription for eyeglass lenses, frames, or contact lenses at any Vision Essentials by Kaiser Permanente optical store. Find Vision Essentials information online at kp2020.org.

Southern and Northern Colorado members may also use your benefit credit at an affiliated optometrist's office. If you pay for your frames, lenses, or contact lenses out-of-pocket, you will need to submit a claim for reimbursement for your benefit allowance amount.

Vision exams are covered under the medical portion of your benefit plan, and a copayment may apply. Refer to your *Summary of Benefits and Coverage* for your optical credit amount, and other eye care or vision benefit information.
