- No. 5—(The Dissmore Ditch, increased appropriation May 31, 1875.
(The Puett Ditch, original construction May 31, 1875.
- No. 6—The Abbott & Prengle Ditch, original construction May 13, 1876.
- No. 7—The Jake Wells Ditch, increased appropriation April 1, 1877.
- No. 8—The Lemaster Ditch, original construction October 31, 1879.
- No. 9—The Prengle Ditch, increased appropriation May 30, 1880.
- No. 10—The Lemaster Ditch, 1st increased appropriation May 30, 1885.
- No. 11—The Lemaster Ditch, 2nd increased appropriation April 1, 1889.

(15th)—That the ditches taking water from Dissmore Creek (a tributary to Texas Creek) are entitled of Dissmore Creek priorities as follows, to-wit:

- No. 2—The Dissmore Ditch No. 2, original construction June 30, 1875.
